

PRIVACY POLICY

McRae Law Limited ("MLL") may collect information about you when you access or use its website.

MLL may retain and update personal information collected from or provided by you.

The internet is not a secure environment. Information you send to MLL is sent at your own risk.

MLL may store your personal information in hardcopy form or in electronic form, including with third party data storage facilities and in cloud storage located in or outside New Zealand.

MLL may use your personal information:

- For the purpose for which it was collected;
- To deal with commercial or legal conflicts;
- To conduct customer due diligence on you as required by the Anti- Money Laundering and Countering Financing of Terrorism Act 2009 and associated regulations;
- To obtain credit and other references about you;
- To provide legal services to you;
- To undertake credit management (including debt recovery);
- To send you invitations or publications or tell you about issues and developments that may be of interest to you; and
- For specific purposes you authorize.

MLL may disclose personal information about you if:

- It is required or authorized by you;
- It is required or permitted by law or the Law Society's Rules of Professional Conduct.
